Yemen and Afghanistan have one of the highest rates of chronic malnutrition. HCI mobilize to address communal needs. Over the last few years, HCI has built and operated bakeries in these regions that provide 4000 fresh loaves of bread daily to families living in poverty.

The same thing that provides our lives with comfort is limiting the quality of life for millions worldwide – water.

It's impossible to overstate the importance of clean drinking water. Access to clean water keeps children in school, prevents early death, and reduces poverty by enabling communities to build an economy and agriculture for trade and sustenance.

This Ramadan, we're proud to say that we've raised for more than 400 water wells, translating into more than 300,000 lives impacted.







Orphans receive support in food aid, water, shelter, clothing, and access to education and medical care. Receiving sponsorship means that the child has an opportunity to live their childhood, fulfill their potential through education, and be safe from exploitation and poverty.

The orphan is disadvantaged in a multitude of ways. Without a caretaker, they often fall victim to exploitation, poverty, and neglect.

As such, the Prophet (saw), putting his two fingers side by side, said, "I will be like this in Jannah with the person who takes care of an orphan."

This Ramadan, our donors, and community members sponsored 469 children. Thanks to you, these children have a chance at a better life.



SUSTAINABILITY PROJECTS

HAMAN CONCEP

One of HCI's newest projects this year is the Hope Village project in northern Syria. The new village provided housing for internally displaced Syrian families, offering a return to normalcy, stability, dignity, and a place called home.

The village comes with a school for children to advance their education and a mosque for communal gatherings and worship. Each home has two rooms, a kitchen, a washroom, and a living room.

With your support, HCI has contributed to covering the costs of housing 130 families!
