WINTER RELIEF PROGRAM

HCl's Winter Relief Program addresses three issues: cold related diseases, malnutrition, and the mental well-being of families living under the poverty line. Our work prioritizes children and women who are the most vulnerable.

In a world where the climate has been changing drastically and the temperatures during the winter drops down in certain zones to below -30°C, families living in poverty can't afford protecting themselves and beloved ones from the harsh winter cold. COVID-19 crisis made it even harder for the families depending on the day to day wages with the curfews and lockdowns that resulted in global economic disruption. Your donations provided warmth, food and drew smiles on the faces of families in need.

INTERNATIONAL EFFORTS: IMPACT

Your donation matters, they count on you!

Through your support, HCl's **Winter Relief Program** was able to make a significant impact this season. Your donations helped address critical issues like lack of shelter and appropriate clothing, cold related diseases, malnutrition, and the mental well-being of families living under the poverty line. Almost **5,000** families were supported, with more than **23,000** individuals receiving aid.

THE BREAK DOWN

SYRIA

Food aid as well as winter clothes, blankets, solar lamps, and hygiene kits were distributed to **586 families**.

BANGLADESH

Blankets, winter clothes and food baskets were distributed to 1,000 families.

ROHINGYA

Winter jackets for children & adults and blankets were distributed to 951 families.

MOROCCO

The houses of **12 families** in the slums of Rabat were repaired, and new washroom facilities were installed for each unit.

AFGHANISTAN

Heaters, winter clothes, food aid and hygiene kits were distributed to 140 families.

EMERGENCY RESPONSES: SYRIA & INDONESIA

SYRIAN CAMPS FLOODED

WINTER RELIEF FOR SYRIAN REFUGEES

Heavy rains surprised the residents of more than 26 camps/communities in the province of Idlib and flooded their tents. At least 45,000 people were affected by the floods and lost their tents and belongings. The majority of these camps were established on open agriculture areas which turned into mud swamp with the rain fall.

Human Concern International delivered shelter, heating, and food to 2222.

INDONESIA ROCKED

WINTER RELIEF FOR EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS

A 6.2 magnitude earthquake rocked West Sulawesi, Indonesia. More than 800 people were injured, more than 40 were declared dead, and 300 houses were completely destroyed. Human Concern International responded immediately with a team on the ground to deliver relief and help the families transition back into their normal lives. **HCI delivered blankets, mattresses, food and diapers to 5,000 people.**
