




Your Generosity in Action

1. Food Security Initiatives


You fed **299,998 people** across **11 countries,** of which **46,100** feeds were from your Zakat al-Fitr donations. Food packs were distributed to vulnerable families, each thoughtfully designed and tailored to regional dietary needs to include staples, protein sources, nutrient-rich foods, and additional essentials.





Food packs included rice, flour, sugar, salt, ghee, lentils, chicken, eggs, cheese, beans / chickpeas, dates, tomato paste, vegetables, oil, tea, sauces.

People fed by country




2. Child Sponsorship Program (CSP)

This Ramadan, you sponsored **2,987 children.** Your support provided **Eid clothes, toys,** and **monthly in-kind assistance** (food, clothing, hygiene kits, and nutritional supplements), bringing relief and joy to children and their families. The project also supported a total number of **13,650** monthly indirect beneficiaries (siblings/ family members).

In Gaza alone, **1,000 orphaned children** and **2,577 family** members received critical support, along with psychosocial activities for healing and connection.





3. Livelihood & Healthcare Services

Through our healthcare services and medical evacuation support initiatives, Human Concern USA delivered critical care to families in **Syria** and **Gaza**, provided ongoing support to medical evacuees from Gaza in **Turkiye** and **Egypt**, and extended healthcare assistance to the elderly in Bosnia.

- Gaza: Psychosocial health and support activities provided to 177 children
- Syria Village of Hope: Healthcare services provided to
 2,618 people
- Bosnia: Healthcare services provided to 165 elderly
- **Egypt:** Monthly essential assistance, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support, and medical support provided to **1,294** Gaza evacuees


Turkiye: Monthly essential assistance, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support, and medical support provided to

4. Education

Across Syria, Turkiye, Egypt, and Pakistan,
Human Concern USA remained steadfast
in its commitment to education as a
pathway to long-term recovery and
empowerment.





- Syria Hope Village School: 1,141 individuals supported through education, psychosocial programming, and staff training.
- Turkiye Scholarships for Palestinian
 Students: 126 students received scholarships
 and support, benefiting 500+ family members
 through reduced financial strain and long
 -term impact.
- Education Center in Egypt: 387 students & 10 teachers supported
- Gaza Medical Student Support: 1,096 students and 44 faculty received monthly academic support.
- Pakistan Deaf Education Scholarships:
 185 students received comprehensive support and learning tools, benefiting
 1,500 family members through improved communication and reduced caregiving needs.
